OUTSTANDING MATTERS

- Management of stormwater upstream screening of sedimentation pond to be considered. Additional
 information required regarding the capacity of the sediment dam. Assessment report to consider
 program of monitoring.
- Existing regulatory issues on the site
- Transport impacts outlined including existing road damage from the quarry operations.
 - o Additional information required regarding proposed scale and timing of operations
 - o Additional information required regarding specifications for Kingstown Road entrance.
 - Traffic assessment and safety audit to be considered in relation to ascertaining the number and impact of future vehicular movements.
 - Assessment report to consider management of traffic and safety impacts, including ongoing management of speed and vehicular movements.
 - Assessment report to consider scheduled infrastructure upgrades and contributions in line with existing contributions plan(s).
- Rehabilitation Plan to be outlined in the assessment report, including measures to ensure works are undertaken progressively and at the cessation of operations, considering an independent assessor.

- Biodiversity addition information required in relation to current footprint and contributions. Assessment report to consider biodiversity impacts and rehabilitation management plan.
- Groundwater interaction impacts to be addressed
- Aboriginal heritage assessment report to outline the proposed protection and management of heritage
