

# **NOTES:**

+ Denotes **Dichondra repens** planting can be reinforced or substituted with seed sown application. Apply seed mix to manufacturers instructions

Trees within or bordering carpark to be spaced at approx 6m centres. Ensure trees are evenly spaced at either side of pedestrian crossing/walkway where it intersects these garden beds

## LAWNS

Establishment: Following installation of new turf the lawn shall be watered daily during the first week and 3 times per week for the following three (3) weeks until root establishment has been achieved. Do not fertilise during this period.

Maintenance: Once established the lawn shall be mown to a minimum of 25mm height when required. Fertilise in spring when lawn shows signs of post winter growth with a complete slow release lawn food ensuring to water well before and after. Complete followup lawn feeding during summer and autumn with an organic fertiliser following the manufacturers instructions for application methods and

Watering of lawns should be conducted with regards to current water restriction guidelines. Water lawns deeply for longer periods less often rather than frequent light applications to promote healthy deep root growth. This will improve the turfs drought tolerance.

## SHRUBS

Establishment: In the absence on an installed irrigation system, plants should be watered regularly to ensure plants are receiving adequate moisture given their individual microclimates in which they are planted and encourage deep root growth. Tip prune leafy shrubs as required to promote dense bushy habit and maintain desired shape. Remove any spent flowers and dead foliage as necessary

### HEDGING

Maintenance: Hedging plants should be pruned regularly during the growing season to produce a dense screen with a more bushy habit. This is achieved by reducing the internodal length(Length between branching points) and promoting multiple branching. Pruning should commence once the plants are established and may involve removing up to  $\frac{1}{3}$  of the new growth from both the sides and top of the plant. After pruning apply a soluable plant food such as Sealsol and Nitrolsol to promote root and leaf growth. Water plants regularly on permitted days until plants have established and then continue to water regularly especially during the drier months.

Fertilise plants with a complete slow release fertiliser suitable for native plants Fertilising: throughout the growing season and apply an organic fertiliser such as blood and bone at the beginning of spring. Fertilising should be reduced by half in winter and a low nitrogen fertiliser used only.

### **TREES**

Establishment: Advanced trees should be staked during the establishment period with 3 hardwood stakes outside the rootball area and tethered by 3 hessian ties in figure eight pattern between stake and tree. Once a strong root system is established the stakes should be removed to promote strong stem growth.

Pyrus calleryana - Selected specimens with dominant central leaders should only be used.

Note: All fertilising shall be completed following the manufacturers instructions regarding the frequency and rates of application of each individual product.

















