KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

- Background to proposed development, noting
 - o refusal of application for subdivision (mid 1990s)
 - approval and subsequent minor modifications for solar farm, including amendment to Condition 18 relating to heritage requirements
- Connection between the heritage listed homestead (Palmerston House) and the curtilage extent and management
- Previous Land and Environment Court decision in mid 1990's recognising significant relationship between the homestead and open rural setting adjoining which extends to the hawthorn hedge
- Solar farm ability to provide diversification of income stream and ongoing management and maintenance of heritage item consideration in assessment and granting of approval for the solar farm
- Requirements of a Conservation Management Plan (CMP) and differences with a Heritage Asset Action Plan (HAAP)
- Current consent requires a CMP to cover the homestead, curtilage (including hawthorn hedge) and all
 the existing items including opportunities for adaptive reuse (current uses/opportunities),
 management and maintenance
- Consideration of a HAAP noting Council's opinion it includes insufficient detail (coverage and extent of curtilage of the site)
