# PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and briefings listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

### Application for modification of consent

The Panel determined to approve the modification application pursuant to section 4.55(2) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

# **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The Panel determined to approve the application for the reasons outlined in the Council Assessment Report.

The Panel agreed the development as modified is substantially the same as that approved.

The Panel was satisfied that parking provision remains adequate and that the café function is ancillary to the primary use.

# CONDITIONS

The Development Application was approved subject to the conditions in the Council Assessment Report and Amended Draft Conditions (V1 - 23/01/2024).
