- Performance safety of the roundabout speed limit to be assessed
- 2 proposed trees identified on landscape plans to the east of the helipad but not shown on architectural/development plans clarification required of proposal
- Provision of EV charging points/provision for future installation (servicing infrastructure)

- Location of the accessible parking in relation to the Fire Control Centre entry door
- Frontage/access off the Old Newell Highway and future access across the railway line
