DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST	George Cecato advised that he is a member of the Coffs Coast Regional Park Trust Board. He declared that he has not taken part in any discussions regarding this development application while on the board. He did participate in the meeting. Cath Fowler advised that she has been nominated to the Coffs Coast Regional Park Trust Board. She did participate in the meeting.

Public meeting held by teleconference on 23 April 2025, opened at 1.11pm and closed at 2.25pm.

MATTER DETERMINED

PPSNTH-367 – Coffs Harbour – 0220/25DA – Ti-Tree Road, 15 & 17 Pine Crescent, Sandy Beach – Subdivision (113 residential lots, 1 Biodiversity Stewardship Lot, dedication of reserves) (as described in Schedule 1).

PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and briefings listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

Application to vary a development standard:

A written request from the applicant, made under cl 4.6 (3) of the Coffs Harbour Local Environmental Plan 2013 (LEP), has not been considered as the Panel has determined to refuse the development application.

Development application

The Panel determined to refuse the development application pursuant to section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The Panel determined to refuse the application for the reasons outlined in the Council Assessment Report and Attachment A Reasons for Refusal.

CONDITIONS

Not applicable

CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNITY VIEWS

In coming to its decision, the Panel considered written submissions made during public exhibition and heard from all those wishing to address the Panel. The Panel notes that issues of concern included:

- Flood and stormwater impacts upon existing neighbourhood
- Likely adverse construction impacts on Hearnes Lake and impacts from additional pedestrian use
- Impact on biodiversity

- Suitability/capability of existing road system and intersections to accommodate the additional traffic demand
- Amenity related traffic impacts including noise and head light impacts
- Construction related amenity impacts including associated traffic, noise and dust from vehicles delivering fill and undertaking earthworks
- Compliance with concept approval issued by the NSW Department of Planning in 2010
- No public consultation occurring as part of the preparation of the Environmental Impact Statement. This was a requirement of the Secretary's Environmental Assessment Requirements (SEARS)
- Public services (existing schools, medical centres, emergency services etc) are insufficient to support such a large-scale development
- Privacy and visual intrusion impacts for existing residences adjoining the development
- Adverse community impact due to increased densities and overcrowding

The Panel considers that concerns raised by the community have been adequately addressed in the Assessment Report and that no new issues requiring assessment were raised during the public meeting.
