KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

- Council will have its assessment report peer reviewed by an independent consultant before providing it to the Planning Panel
- Scope and layout of proposed development
- Assessment report is to include consideration of permissibility of all proposed uses, including whether they are specifically defined or considered as ancillary to the predominant use
- Clause 4.6 Variation to minimum lot size for a dwelling is substantial (being 83% variation) - justification for the variation is to be detailed in the assessment report although may be better to classify the dwelling as ancillary to the main use
- 14 caravan spaces included, again perhaps best classified as ancillary
- Potential environmental effect of pets brought into area by users of caravan park
- Volunteer accommodation – length of stay and permissibility
- If accommodation facilities are not permissible in zone, it may be possible to find alternate accommodation in vicinity?
- Panel will require appropriate conditions to be imposed – Council to keep ancillary uses in mind when drafting conditions
- SEPP 55 assessment for all proposed uses, including residential, is to be included in the assessment report and not just the predominant use
