KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

- Safety in relation to potential flooding and the need for a flood plan and evacuation plan, considering that the proposal is for critical infrastructure and a flood barrier is likely to be required in relation to the PMF
- RMS traffic requirements for Darcy Road in the context of the Westmead Medical and Education precinct access and road widening requirements
- Public domain and accessibility importance of sufficiently wide sidewalks

• Noise impacts for neighbouring properties due to extended plant room which extends beyond the height plane.
