#### **MATTER DETERMINED**

PPSSCC-256 – Cumberland – DA2021/0273, 13-21 Parramatta Road, Lidcombe, staged construction and operation of a mixed-use development comprising a service station and commercial offices including associated alterations to the adjoining Costco site, landscaping and civil works (as described in Schedule 1).
