### ITEMS DISCUSSED

- Introductions.
- Applicant summary:
  - Site is located within the Hills Showground Station Precinct and nominated as a future mixed-use local centre as part of the North West Rail Link Corridor Strategy.
  - The proposal seeks consent for subdivision works, including construction of a local road, and public domain works including a new neighbourhood park, public art and landscaping to the new road. The public domain lots will be handed to Council for ownership and ongoing maintenance.
  - A modification to the concept masterplan was lodged in 2021 to DPE to reduce the size of the park and change the one-way section of the internal road to two ways, upon receipt of advice from TfNSW.
  - Site investigations included consultation and broad community engagement in August 2021.
- Council summary:
  - Discussions previously held with Council's landscaping team regarding the park design and maintenance requirements.
  - Timing of handover of the park and mechanism to do so.
  - Subdivision works subject to an existing SSD application. The civil component is currently under assessment by Council's engineering team.
- Public exhibition is underway. Nil submissions received to date. Electronic determination possible, depending on total number of submissions.
- Council is yet to undertake its full application assessment, so this record is not a final list of the issues they will need to consider in order to draft their recommendation.
- Initial Request for Additional Information issued 7 February 2022 relating to TfNSW, Sydney Metro, Council's Open Space and Recreation team and Planning comments. Further information may be requested upon completion of outstanding referrals.
- Application is reliant on the approval of the modification to the Concept SSDA application.
- The application is yet to be considered by the Sydney Central City Planning Panel and therefore future comment will not be limited to the detail contained within.
