The panel will meet to determine the following:

- PPSSCC-14- Cumberland DA-171-2019 69 and 71 Pegler Ave, South Granville - Demolition of existing dwellings and construction of a 3 storey residential flat building comprising 18 units over one level of basement car parking for 11 vehicles, associated landscaping and land consolidation pursuant to SEPP Affordable Rental Housing 2009
- PPSSCC-11 Cumberland DA94/2019 2-36 Church Street, Lidcombe Demolition of existing structures and construction of 4 residential flat buildings of varying heights from 4 to 10 storeys, comprising 262 units (including 53 social housing units) over basement car parking for 328 vehicles, pursuant to SEPP (Affordable Rental Housing) 2009, and construction of a roundabout at the intersection of Martin Street and Church Street.
- PPSSCC-33 Cumberland DA 2019/141/1 11-17 Joyner St, Westmead Demolition of existing structures, consolidation of four (4) allotments, and construction of a five (5) storey residential flat building under State Environmental Planning Policy (Affordable Rental Housing) 2009 comprising 46 Units (including 12 dual key units) over two (2) levels of basement parking for 57 vehicles and a car wash bay
