KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Have requested additional information from applicant (Council), including shadow diagrams.
- A Remediation Action Plan (RAP) was submitted in response to Council's RFI letter. The RAP
 recommends that further contamination investigations be conducted post-demolition of buildings
 on-site to confirm soil contamination. The Panel noted that demolition is the subject of a separate
 consent issued by Council and that consent was issued prior to the submission of the RAP.
 Accordingly, Council will recommend a draft condition of consent requiring the investigation of soil
 and amendment of the RAP as necessary post-demolition but prior to the commencement of
 construction.
- Assessment report is close to finalisation, and is currently being circulated internally. Anticipate submission to the Panel Secretariat for electronic determination towards the end of the month.
- Emerging issues:

- Location of pedestrian link is central to the public domain rather than along the eastern edge per the DCP. The variation is supported by Council.
- On-site detention system: on-site detention is not proposed, however this is supported by Council drainage engineers.
- Submission: single submitter, queried treatment on site boundary of adjoining land on eastern side, which it is intended to redevelop in the future.
- Council considers that these issues can be resolved without delaying the assessment process.
- As it's a Council DA, Council representatives have declared a conflict and will not participate in decision-making.

The Panel supports progress to a determination as soon as possible, noting the above.

DETERMINATION DATE: end of March / early April 2022
