## **KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED**

- As the previous Briefing Record noted The Panel agrees with Council that the under-provision of carparking is a substantive issue to be addressed, due to potential rates of car ownership of tenants, and the location of the proposal in relation to good public transport access. It is requested that the applicant explore all potential ways in which this shortfall could be addressed.
- To assist the Panel's considerations, it is requested that Council provide information and the proximity, frequency and destinations of the bus service that is downhill from the site.
- Further exploration and guidance provided on the statutory requirements in relation to the parking provision is requested.
- Clarity as provided that this application is for social not affordable housing and that the site is 700 metres from the train station.
