MATTER DETERMINED

PPSSCC-346 – Blacktown - SPP-21-00012 - 45-47 Johnson Ave, Seven Hills – Demolition of minor structures, site works and construction of a single storey building for use as vocational education and training facility with related carparking and landscaping.
