Chair reviewed attendance and introduced Kick Off Briefing purpose and process.

Applicant

- Applicant outlined the background to and purpose of the proposed development. The
 Applicant described the site, context of the development within the broader campus,
 features of the existing swimming pool, surrounding built form and land use and
 details of the proposed development and intended use.
- The applicant addressed key considerations of the proposed development including:
 - o parking and access.
 - o landscaping and biodiversity.
 - o flood and stormwater management.
 - o environmental and heritage matters.

Council

- Council advised that at this stage of the assessment they have not identified any significant or fundamental issues with the application.
- Council advised they are awaiting response to their RFI, noting that the Applicant has requested an extension of time for return of information which Council has granted.
- Notification period concluded no submissions received.

Panel

- The Chair noted that given no submissions were received that this matter will proceed to Electronic Determination.
- The Chair recommended the expeditious resolution of matters raised within Council's RFI and reiterated the Panel's intent to provide determination on RSDAs within the 250 day target.
