- 1 Refuse DA-24-00024 based for the following reasons:
  - The proposal is not consistent with the relevant environmental planning instruments including the provisions of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979, State Environmental Planning Policy (Central River City) 2021, State Environmental Planning Policy (Biodiversity and Conservation) 2021 and Blacktown Growth Centres Development Control Plan 2010 [Section 4.15(a) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979].
  - Suitability of the development cannot be confirmed as there is insufficient and inadequate information on the proposed road and drainage design and for waste management [Section 4.15(b) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979].
  - Based on the issues raised in relation to road network design, residential character, potential residential amenity and traffic impacts and drainage, the site is considered unsuitable for the proposed development [Section 4.15(c) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979].
  - The public submission raised the issue of traffic impacts which has not been sufficiently addressed by the proposal [Section 4.15(d) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979].
  - For the reasons outlined above, granting of consent to the development in its current form is not in the public interest [Section 4.15(1)(e) of the EP&A Act 1979].
