## **DISCUSSION POINTS**

The Panel inspected the whole site and observed the significant changes in levels and the proposed changes to site entry points. The Applicant explained various aspects of the proposed development in light of Council's comprehensive RFI, including:

- Construction staging
- Earth shaping and extent of cut and fill, as well as control of potential landslip
- Vehicular and pedestrian access from Old Northern Road and Palisander Place (pre and post construction)
- Stormwater
- Landscaping and open space
- Accessibility and way through
- Parking
- Building height and density

Both the Panel and Council requested the Applicant prepare and submit to Council a draft Construction Traffic Management Plan for review.

Target date for determination remains March 2025. Council to confirm with the Secretariat early in the New Year. The Panel noted that the Applicant is finalising a response to the matters listed in the RFI and subject to Council's review, renotification of the application may be necessary.
