PPSSCC-63 - City of Parramatta - DA/739/2019

5 Uhrig Road, Lidcombe

Construction of 579 residential apartments in three towers and a low scale building, seven-storey commercial building, associated parking, landscaping, public domain works and subdivision.

KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Town centre location in Carter Street Precinct. Noted that DPIE guidance is required to progress the application.
- Panel considers further work is required on the urban design and layout of the site to address street and public domain interface, surveillance opportunities and solar access.
- In particular:
 - Cranking of buildings should be reviewed, with ground level podiums ideally providing street
 interface. Where cranking or setbacks are intended to create 'pocket parks' it must be ensured that
 these are in locations where solar access is optimal throughout the day, and the design of the spaces
 are well detailed to facilitate public use.
 - The townhouse building typology should be revisited, noting that this typology is unusual for a town centre location, and as currently designed it does not create an ideal street interface, and the internal courtyards appear to have poor amenity and limited solar access. A different, street perimeter typology could potentially provide greater solar access opportunities, as well as better public domain interface.
