PPSSEC-119 – Bayside – DA-2019/47/B – 1-5 Chalmers Crescent, Mascot (as described in Schedule 1)

PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

Development application

The Panel determined to approve the development application pursuant to section 4.55 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The Panel determined to approve the application for the reasons outlined in the Council Officer's assessment report.

• The Panel notes the unique planning circumstances of this site where half of the site has no nominated floor space ratio and that the proposed modification is simply a redistribution of floor space across the whole site which does not result in any adverse environmental impact.

The development application was approved subject to the conditions in the Council Officer's assessment report.
