ISSUES DISCUSSED

Applicant:

- History of the site
- Zoning, height limit (breach relates to the plant rooms), setbacks (generally compliant), parking, flooding (1.5m flooding at boundary, proposing to double existing easement and stormwater infrastructure infrastructure), shadowing, and vehicle access.
- Requested removal of existing traffic calming infrastructure on Baxter Road.

Council:

- Revised flood report to be provided and additional contamination report to confirm site suitability
- Noted the proposed height breach is minor and consistent with surrounding development.
- Discussed proposed vehicle access at eastern end of the site, noted potential for conflicts between proposed vehicle access and existing neighbouring vehicle access and existing traffic calming infrastructure.

Panel:

- Queried the signage treatment and the landscaping adjacent to the rail line. Applicant confirmed landscaping would be included.
- Requested consistent Design Review Panel membership.
- Traffic committee advice to be provided on traffic calming and vehicle access
- Details of building material, urban design contribution etc requested.
