DISCUSSION ITEMS

Introductions

- Applicant summary:
 - Construction of two storey multipurpose hall for the use of a place of public worship and a community facility, basement and at-grade parking, signage, tree removal and associated landscape works.
 - Restoration and adaptive reuse of the existing church hall for a childcare facility for 49 children and
 - o Demolition of existing dwelling at 1A Dunmore Street North.
 - Existing locality context summary.
 - Pre-DA meeting held January 2022 church must be retained, and the location of the new multi-purpose hall was not sympathetic to the heritage significance of the surrounding items. A recommendation was made for more trees and landscaping on site.
 - Proposed roof plane fronting Western elevation (Dunmore Street North) deals with solar access to adjoining residential development.
- Council is yet to undertake its full application assessment, so this record is not a final list of the issues they will need to consider in order to draft their recommendation.
- The application is yet to be considered by the Sydney Eastern City Planning Panel and therefore future comment will not be limited to the detail contained within.

KEY ISSUES IDENTIFIED FOR CONSIDERATION

- Landscaping and canopy trees to screen/buffer proposed roof of western elevation.
- Carparking rates and transport (Council's DCP requires 9 spaces for the childcare centre, Church congregations on a weekend can use the childcare spaces).
- Separate DA for specialist disability accommodation in corner of site submitted. DDA compliant parking spaces will be located within the basement level. Interim access and parking arrangement proposed until both applications are lodged and determined concurrently. Access and parking is to be provided independently and insight to be provided as part of subject application and any potential conditions issued under a consent.
- Amenity impacts to adjoining residential development.
- Protection, retention and enhancing trees.
- Heritage protection and adaptive re-use. Proposed signage is not supported.
- Proposed elevation of building above ground level. Council's preference for basement to be partially contained under natural ground level to reduce the overall height. Accessibility would then be achieved at the ground level plane.
- Accessibility within the proposed childcare centre.
- Inconsistency between documents.
