- Industrial site with existing buildings. UTS moving into a second building to expand campus on-site ٠ for engineering and R&D. DA is mainly for fit-out and fire upgrade. Approx. 570 parking spaces on site and no additional spaces required. Will be 24/7 access. No residential proposed.
- A pre-DA meeting was held and matters addressed •
- Site surrounded by other industry •
- Exhibition closed end January 2023 and no public submissions received •
- DA only required due to wetlands at site corner and biodiversity issues (otherwise would be • exempt and complying development)
- All external referrals received and no issues raised by council (awaiting internal engineering • comments)
- Applicant has asked for development consent to ensure DA can be delivered in stages. Council will • work with applicant re conditions given Crown DA.
- No RFI required other than landscaping query

- No noise remediation required as per acoustic report for student purposes from industry, planes or trains
