 - Turning circle for B99 vehicles, resulting in a reduction in the footprint of Building, including turning circle dimensions
 - Setback of Building C, resulting in a reduction of the footprint (10m with an additional 3m colonnade)
 - Drop off zone consultation performance requirements for buses and cars/vans, noting NIDA request

- Matters noted from the Record of Deferral:
