MATTER DETERMINED

PPSSEC-283 – Canada Bay – MOD2023/0082 – 2, 2A, 4 Rothwell Avenue, Concord West – Modification to approved DA2019/0160 to construct 3 additional private roof terraces and to modify apartments below for roof access (as described in Schedule 1).

PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and briefings and the matters observed at site inspection listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

Application for modification of consent

The Panel determined to approve the modification application pursuant to section 4.55(2) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The Panel is satisfied that the application is substantially the same development and the reasons for the original approval have been taken into consideration for this determination.

The Panel determined to approve the modification application for the reasons outlined in the Council Assessment Report.

CONDITIONS

The Modification Application was approved subject to the conditions in the Council Assessment Report.

CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNITY VIEWS

In coming to its decision, the Panel considered written submissions made during public exhibition. The Panel notes that issues of concern included:

- Additional height creating disparity between development and surrounding development
- Loss of privacy
- Further obstruction of views
- Impacts on dwellings between Rothwell Avenue and George Street
- Impact on solar access
- Additional impact on parking and traffic

The Panel considers that concerns raised by the community have been adequately addressed in the Assessment Report. The Panel notes that in addressing these issues appropriate conditions have been imposed.
