## **KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED**

## Council briefing - 3.00pm - 3.40pm

- Site location and context outlined
- Existing development on site noted as a recycling facility with identified capacity limitations
- Minor modification to original proposal in 2023
- Proposed modification to increase the throughput for up to 4 years, then reverting to current approval
  - o Change in hours of operation to enable Sunday operation
  - No building works proposed
- Predicted noise levels provided in Acoustic Report, with no noise monitoring provided for current operations
- Noise complaints received post commencement of operations, with monitoring required as part of original consent (but not provided)
- Peer review of acoustic report undertaken
- Submissions noted potential traffic impact on nearby sporting facilities on Sundays
- Confirmation to be provided regarding classification as a modification

# **Planning Panels Secretariat**

- Proposal background outlined, noting loss of facility in Hume, ACT
- Recycling materials being sent to a number of other facilities
- Extended hours of receival at existing facility to accommodate trucks travelling from Hume until new Material Recycling Facility (MRF) at Hume is operational (up to 4 years)
- Sunday operations proposed as required to provide contingency for equipment down time
- Substantially the same development noting continuation as a MRF, same type of materials, minor increase in hours of operation and no built form works proposed
- Noise acoustic modelling provided, noting noise predictions are within the required noise limits

- Clarification of proposed Sunday operation and request for a draft Operational Plan of Management to outline the proposed Sunday operations
- Consideration of option for reduced hours on a Sunday
- Noise Audits to be provided
