### MATTER DETERMINED

PPSSEC-286 – Strathfield – DA2015.177.3 – 40-42 Madeline Street Strathfield South – S4.55(2) Modification Application to temporarily change hours of operation and enable the processing of additional throughput for the materials recycling facility at the site to 120,000 tonnes per annum (as described in Schedule 1).

## PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and briefings and the matters listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

## Application for modification of consent

The Panel is satisfied that the application is substantially the same development and the reasons for the original approval have been taken into consideration for this determination. The Panel has also had regard to the submissions received.

The Panel determined to approve the modification application pursuant to section 4.55(2) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

## **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The Panel determined to approve the application for the reasons outlined in the Council Assessment Report.

## CONDITIONS

The modification application was approved subject to the conditions in the Council Assessment Report and revised conditions with the following amendments.

Amend Condition 9(c) to include the following at the end of the last sentence:
 A copy of the reports are to be provided to Council's Director of Planning within fourteen (14) days from the completion of each audit.

## CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNITY VIEWS

In coming to its decision, the Panel considered written submissions made during public exhibition. The Panel notes that issues of concern included:

- Hours of operation
- Noise impacts
- Traffic impacts and road network
- Hours of operation adjacent sites
- Designated development requirements
- Waste impacts

- Previous consent conditions
- Compliance with conditions of consent
- Air quality impacts

The Panel considers that concerns raised by the community have been adequately addressed in the Assessment Report. The outside storage of waste was noted as a condition of consent and a matter of non-compliance to be considered by Council in their regulatory function.

The Panel notes that in addressing these, appropriate conditions have been imposed. The outside storage of waste was noted in Condition 38 of DA2015.177 and reinforced in Condition 100(a) of these conditions.
