PPSNTH-287 – Canada Bay – DA2023/0158 – 444, 446 Concord Road, 33, 35, 37 39, 41 Blaxland Road, 1, 3, 5 Llewellyn Street, Rhodes – Proposed integrated development including excavation and construction of a mixed-use development. Mixed used development consists of a podium and two tower forms between 9 and 28 storeys, 285 residential apartments, a medical centre, childcare centre, and commercial and retail tenancies, with associated landscaping and 5 levels of basement car parking
