PPSSEC-302 – Bayside – DA-2023/361 – 75, 81 & 83-85 Railway Street, Rockdale – Retention of existing heritage facade of building at Nos. 83-85 Railway Street, demolition of all other structures, construction of a 9-storey mixed-use development comprising of ground floor commercial, 140 residential units, basement parking, associated landscaping and Voluntary Planning Agreement (VPA) for public domain works

## **KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED**

- Site context provided, noting location of heritage items and other surrounding development
- Planning control noted as:
  - o zoning E1 Local Centre
  - height of building controls 28m (83-85 Railway St) and 22m (75-81 Railway St) height controls on the site
    - variation proposed 32.17m (11.3% variation 75-81 Railway St) and 28.39m proposed (29% variation 83-85 Railway St)
  - o no floor space ratio control for the site
  - acid sulphate soils
  - design excellence
  - o probable maximum flood
  - ANEF
- Proposal outlined, noting demolition of existing buildings and construction of mixed use development
- Building setback controls in development control plan and Apartment Design Guidelines applies
- Voluntary Planning Agreement (VPA) existing over part of the site

- Submitted plans illustrate additional new public laneway that does not form part of the VPA
- Design Review Panel (DRP) meeting held in December 2022 pre-DA lodged and request for Design Review Panel comments
- Additional Information sent, with application to be re-referred to the DRP
- External Referrals
  - Sydney Airport Corporation Ltd and Water NSW unresolved
  - Sydney Trains, Ausgrid, Sydney Water resolved
- Internal Referrals
  - o Environmental Scientist, Development Engineer, Building, Landscape unresolved
  - o Waste and Heritage resolved
- Site contamination to be investigated
- Lack of deep soil provided, noting roof-top landscaped area
- Onsite stormwater detention tank, noting location in the laneway with preference to be relocated to on-site
- Submissions 22 received
- Loading/unloading bay to be amended to accommodate a heavy rigid vehicle
- EV charging provisions for all residential units
- Private/on-site waste collection

- Further briefing may be required 15 August 2024
- Council to consider if roof-top landscaped area is adequate, noting lack of deep soil area
- Request for clarity of future use of XX area
