KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

- Site location outlined, noting the existing development on the site and surrounding development
- Proposed development noted as demolition of existing flat buildings (24 units) and construction of 8 storey residential flat building
- Mix of apartment sizes proposed
- Site topography requiring substantial excavation
- Insufficient information:
 - Building height, bulk and scale
 - $\circ \quad \text{Desired future character} \quad$
 - o Site facilities
 - Solar access and overshadowing on adjoining building
 - Side and rear fences
 - Site vegetation and tree retention
- Internal referrals:
 - o Development Engineering, Tree and Landscape additional information required
 - o Drainage, Fire Safety, Traffic, Environmental Health, Heritage and Urban Design resolved
