### **MATTER DETERMINED**

PPSSEC-341 - Bayside - DA-2024/286 - 465 & 469 Princes Highway and 5-7 Geeves Avenue, Rockdale - Integrated Development - Demolition of existing structures and construction of a twelve-storey mixed use development consisting of two commercial tenancies at ground floor level with residential co-living above, basement car parking and landscaping (as described in Schedule 1).

### PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and briefings and the matters observed at the site inspection listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

# Application to vary a development standard:

Following consideration of a written request from the applicant, made under s.4.6 (3) of the Bayside Local Environmental Plan 2021 (LEP), the Panel is not satisfied that the applicant has demonstrated that:

- a) compliance with s.4.3 (Height of Buildings) is unreasonable or unnecessary in the circumstances; and
- b) there are sufficient environmental planning grounds to justify contravening the development standard.

The applicant failed to lodge a written request to vary the car parking non-discretionary development standard under the provisions of s.68 of Chapter 3 of the State Environmental Planning Policy (Housing) 2021.

# **Development application**

The Panel determined to refuse the development application pursuant to section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

### **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The Panel determined to refuse the application for the reasons outlined in the Council Assessment Report.

# **CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNITY VIEWS**

In coming to its decision, the Panel considered the written submission made during public exhibition. The Panel notes that issues of concern included:

• Setbacks to commercial level
