PPSSEC-54 – Canada Bay - DA2020/0145 at 121 Parramatta Rd, Five Dock (as described in Schedule 1)

#### PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

## **Development application**

The Panel determined to approve the development application pursuant to section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

### **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The Panel determined to approve the application for the reasons outlined in the Council Officer's assessment report.

- The Panel notes there will be no increase in student numbers and the development is to replace demountable structures in a contemporary building fit for purpose.
- It is also noted by the Panel that the perimeter vegetation is to be retained and this provides an appropriate setting together with the additional landscaping proposed.
- The Panel considers the application is worthy of approval and will provide enhanced amenity for students and teachers alike.

## **CONDITIONS**

The development application is approved subject to the conditions in the Council Officer's assessment report which are to be numbered and with the following amendment.

 Condition currently referred to as DAOUC 12 to read as follows: "All recommendations contained in the approved acoustic assessment report prepared by Rodney Stevens Acoustic Consultants, report date Revision 1, 14th August 2020 shall be adopted, implemented, and adhered to".
