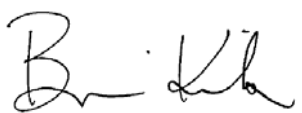
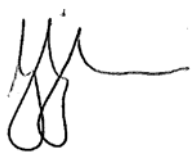
CONDITIONS
