





In my role as Mayor of WCC, I am often asked and expected to be patron of community groups. Club Willoughby is one such group. The Patron role is in all such cases honorary and unpaid, although it may confer membership rights. After careful consideration upon being elected Mayor, and after reflecting on prior accepted practice, I determined fulfilment of the role of patron did not represent a significant nor pecuniary interest. This determination was confirmed in subsequent discussions with both Council officers and SNPP Chairs. With respect to the Club Willoughby proposal, I determined to step aside from the SNPP discussion following concerns expressed regarding a perceived conflict by nearby residents, after discussion with the relevant Panel Chair.

¹ An 'actual' conflict of interests is where there is a direct conflict between a member's duties and responsibilities and their private interests or other duties.

³ A 'reasonably perceived' conflict of interests is where a person could reasonably perceive that a panel member's private interests or other duties are likely to improperly influence the performance of their duties as a panel member, whether or not this is in fact the case.
