- MSB Centre is a 4-storey Interwar building notable for its polychrom e brickwork.
- Building currently used for college admin.







# The Proposal

#### Overview:

Fit-out of the MSB Centre for the purposes of an educational establishment (high school).

#### Particulars:

- Rem oval of 2 trees.
- Demolition of select internal features (primarily non-significant partition walls).
- Partial demolition of southern façade to accommodate new external stair connection.
- Internal fit-out to accommodate new classrooms, study areas and office spaces.
- BCA upgrades (class 9b assem bly).
- Notable external changes:
  - New external stair off southern end of building.
  - Upgraded entry including new pathway, ramp and accessible car space.

# The Proposal

# Key Planning Controls

Land use (Hornsby LEP):

Educational establishments (which includes schools) are permitted with consent in R2 zone.

Height (Hornsby LEP):

- New external stair exceeds 8.5m height limit by approx. 8.7m or 102%.
- Stair is well below ridgeline of the existing building.

ISEPP:

Site fronts classified road (Pennant Hills Road); cll. 10 1 and 10 2 of the ISEPP apply.

Rural Fires Act:

Use is special fire protection purpose; bush fire safety authority must be obtained.
