## **MATTER DEFERRED**

PPSSNH-351 - REV2022/0024, Lot 7094 DP 1059297, 394 Barrenjoey Road NEWPORT, Lot 1 DP 1139445, 394 Barrenjoey Road NEWPORT, Review of Determination of Application DA2021/2173 for alterations and additions and coastal protection works to Newport Surf Life Saving Club (as described in Schedule 1).

## BACKGROUND

The original application was refused by the Sydney North Planning Panel at the Panel meeting on 05 October 2022. The Panel members were Peter Debnam – Chair, Douglas Lord, Graham Brown, Annelise Tuor. Following this meeting, on 29 November 2022, the applicant lodged the current application pursuant to Section 8.2 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 for the review of the Sydney North Planning Panel's determination of refusal for DA2021/2173.

## **REASONS FOR DEFERRAL**

The Panel heard from members of the community, Applicant team and Independent Assessor during the public meeting. Key issues were outlined and considered at length.

The Panel decided to defer the determination to enable further consideration of complex statutory and policy requirements relating this matter and to ensure that an informed decision can be made.

When the Panel has considered these requirements, the Panel will determine the matter electronically.

The Panel's decision to defer the matter was unanimous. The Panel adjourned during the meeting to deliberate on the matter and formulate a resolution
