

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1.0 Introduction

1.1 Background

Transport Strategies has been commissioned by Macquarie Health Corporation to undertake a traffic and parking impact assessment for the proposed alterations and additions to the existing Longueville Private Hospital at 43-47 Kenneth Street, Longueville.

1.2 Purpose of this Report

This report has been prepared to seek a Development Application (DA) approval from Lane Cove Municipal Council to alter and add new facilities and beds to the existing single-storey existing Longueville Private Hospital building with an at-grade carpark. This report sets out an assessment of the anticipated traffic and parking implications of the proposed development.



2.0 Existing Transport Conditions

2.1 Existing Site

The site is Lot 10 of DP1221098 and is located at 43-47 Kenneth Street. Longueville, within the local government area of Lane Cove. The site is located in zoned R2 Low-Density Residential. It is rectangular in shape with an area of approximately 550m². The site has 58m frontages to Kenneth Street and Lorna Leigh Lane and 46m frontage to Christina Street. The surrounding area is primarily comprised of low-density residential uses. The site is currently occupied by three single-storey buildings with a total of 1289.9 m² GFA. The existing Hospital has 22 rooms (29 beds) and does not have any off-street car parking spaces. There are currently 3 registered medical practitioners and 9 employees on the Site at any one time. Patients and staff currently rely on surrounding on-street parking specifically on Christina Street and Kenneth Street. Vehicle access to the off-street loading bay is provided on the western corner of the site along Christina Street (ingress) and the northern corner of the site along Lorna Leigh Lane (egress). There is an existing driveway along Lorna Leigh Lane providing access to the double garage of Longueville Wellness Centre located at 43 Kenneth Street. The existing site plan is shown in Figure 2.1.

2.2 Road Network


Road network around the vicinity of the site is detailed below:

- Kenneth Street is a collector road linking Northwood Road to the northeast and Belcote Road to the southwest. The road generally runs in a northsouth direction with a single lane of traffic in each direction. Kerbside parking is permitted along both sides of the road.
- Christina Street is a local road that connects William Edward Street to the west and Arabella Street to the east. In the vicinity of the site, on-street parking is available along both sides of Christina Street.
- Lorna Leigh Lane is a narrow laneway that terminates with a cul-de-sac on the northern end and connects to Christina Street on the southern end. It provides vehicular and service access to the Hospital and adjacent lowdensity residential developments.

The surrounding road network is shown in Figure 2.3.

2.3 Key Intersections

The key intersections in the vicinity of the site comprise:

- the roundabout intersection at Kenneth Street/ Christina Street.
- the priority-controlled intersections at:
 - William Edward Street/ Christina Street
 - o Christina Street/Lorna Leigh Lane.

2.4 Existing Traffic Conditions

Kenneth Street is a busy collector road and experiences some peak-hour traffic congestion. Observations of traffic activity in the vicinity of the development site during the morning and afternoon peak periods reveal some queuing occurs at times along Kenneth Street due to the traffic congestion at its intersection with Northwood Road. Traffic flows along Christina Street and Lorna Leigh Lane are minor during peak hours.

2.5 Public Transport

The site is well located for public bus services. The nearest bus stop is located 20m to the south of the Hospital on Kenneth Street. The bus stop is serviced by bus route no. 261 (Lane Cove to City King Street Wharf via Longueville) with a 20-minute frequency during peak hours. This bus route also links the site to train services at Wynyard and North Sydney Stations and ferry services at King Street Wharf. The public transport provisions are shown in Figure 2.4 and detailed in

2.6 Cycling Network

The site is well situated within the ever-improving and expanding cycling network within and adjacent to Lane Cove. There is a mix of on-road cycling routes along Kenneth Street. The bicycle network surrounding the site is shown in Figure 2.5.









3.0 Proposal

The proposed development comprises additions to the existing Longueville Private Hospital

The proposal comprises:

- 2.412.9 m² GFA
- 1 additional room (1 bed) on the lower ground level
- 18 additional rooms (19 beds) on the first floor
- Rehabilitation gym
- Hydrotherapy pool
- 4 at-grade car parking spaces including 1 accessible space
- 1 shared ambulance bay/service vehicle bay
- The existing driveways on the Christina Street and Lorna Leigh Lane frontages for the Hospital will be retained.
- The existing driveway on Lorna Leigh Lane frontage for the Wellness Centre will be removed.

In addition to the existing 22 rooms (29 beds), the proposed addition will result in a total of 30 rooms (48 beds).

The proposed development will have up to 4 registered medical practitioners and 12 employees on the site at any one time.

4.0 Parking Requirements

4.1 Council's DCP Car Parking Rates

Council's DCP provides the following criteria in terms of car parking requirements:

Employees 1 space per registered medical practitioner/dentist +

1 space per 2 employees

Visitors 1 space per 3 beds

Application of the DCP criteria reveals the following car parking requirements:

4 registered medical practitioners 4 spaces
12 employees 6 spaces
48 beds 16 spaces
Total 26 spaces

4.2 Adequacy of Car Parking Provision

The proposal will provide 4 car parking spaces (including 1 disabled space) on the site with the following allocation:

- 3 practitioner spaces
- 1 disabled visitor space

Based on the above, it is proposed to provide 3 spaces for staff and 1 disabled space for visitors.

While the number of on-site parking spaces is short of the DCP parking requirement, the provision of 3 on-site car spaces is considered appropriate to accommodate the parking demand associated with the Hospital due to the following key factors:

Consistent with the existing arrangement, any additional demand can be accommodated easily within the existing on-street spaces Kenneth Street, Arabella Street, New Street, Christina Street, Ann Street, William Edward Street, Francis Street, Cowper Street, Dunois Street, Stuart Street (minimum vacancy of 98 spaces).



❖ A review of the 2016 Australian Bureau of Statistics data for Longueville (see Figure 4.1) revealed 52.5% staff drive to/from their workplace.

- ❖ There are realistic transport alternatives to private cars in the locality with the site being directly opposite from the bus stop on Kenneth Street.
- ❖ Due to the lack of on-site parking, some of the car parking demand associated with the Hospital will only be for the short-term use of set-down and pick-up activities during the Hospital's peak hours

It should be noted that Longueville Private Hospital does not allow walk-in without a referral or an appointment. Patients who are referred to the Hospital or those who make appointments will be informed that there will be limited on-site parking and of the other transport options to/from the Site as shown in the following:

Parking

Ample unrestricted parking is available in the vicinity of the hospital.

• Public Transport

Bus Route 261 – from the city, via North Sydney station and Longueville, to Lane Cove. The bus stops are on Kenneth Street across from the Hospital.

• Taxi/Ride-share

Taxi/ ride-share services such as Uber can drop you off directly at the



Hospital's eastern frontage within the No Parking zone (which can accommodate 2 cars) along the western side of Kenneth Street as shown in Figure 4.2.

Ambulance

In the case of an emergency, an ambulance can be called to transport you to the hospital.

Patients can check with the Hospital directly for any specific transport recommendations or assistance, as well as any associated fees and charges for parking or transport services.

The provision of limited on-site parking is consistent with several older hospitals that are located within the R2 Low-Density Residential Zone, where there are limited opportunities to modify the existing site to accommodate additional on-site parking spaces. One of such hospitals in Sydney, which have traditionally operated with limited on-site car space without any safety and operational issues are:

- ❖ Gordon Private Hospital at 746 Pacific Highway, Gordon (Figure 4.3)
- Hunters Hill Private Hospital at 9 Mount Street, Hunters Hill (Figure 4.4)
- Castlecrag Private Hospital at 150 Edinburgh Road, Castlecrag (Figure 4.5)

4.3 DCP Disabled/Adaptable Parking Rate

The DCP requires 1 disabled car parking space to be provided per 25 car spaces (minimum of 1 disabled space) for hospital use. The development proposes 1 disabled car parking space in accordance with the Council's DCP requirements.

4.4 DCP Bicycle Parking Rate

Council's DCP provides the following criteria in terms of bicycle parking requirements:

Employee 1 space per 5 practitioners/professionals

Visitor 1 rack + 1 rack per 200m² GFA

Application of the DCP criteria reveals the following bicycle parking requirements:

4 registered medical practitioners 1 bicycle locker

2,412.9 m² GFA 13 spaces in the form of racks

Based on on-site observation at the existing Hospital, no staff nor visitors cycle



to/from the Hospital. Given the current non-existing usage of bicycle to/from the Hospital, no bicycle parking will be provided on the site.

4.5 Ambulance Access

It is noted that the existing ambulance bay is located off Kenneth Street, as shown in the following Figure 4.6.





The ambulance space will be relocated to the at-grade carpark and be used as a shared loading space/ambulance space with access off Christina Street and egress via Lorna Leigh Lane.

Satisfactory provision is made for access in and out of the shared loading space/ambulance space, as illustrated on the swept path diagrams provided in Appendix C.

It is anticipated that the arrival and departure of an ambulance within the porte-cochere would be managed with the implementation of a Traffic Management Plan. The plan shall include details and instructions pertaining to the use of ambulance along with other drop off – pick up activities.

The ambulance provider will ensure they are in contact with the Hospital management, thus ensuring the vehicle's arrival is anticipated and planned. Such a process will be important in managing ambulance activity to ensure



access to the shared loading/ambulance space by other vehicles is minimally affected at all times.

4.6 Service Vehicle Parking

The waste collection for the Hospital is currently completed by a private waste contractor. The Hospital management will extend the existing private waste collection service to cover the proposed Hospital.

The existing designated loading bay on the ground level will be shared with the ambulance bay.

Refuse will be removed from within the site by an 8.8m long private waste contractor vehicle, with the waste collection taking place outside of the peak hours. Waste collection is expected to occur no more than once a day (typically on weekdays).

It is noted that the servicing elements of the Hospital will generally be privately serviced. As such, a schedule (including ambulance/patient transfer arrival/departure can be developed to suit the servicing needs of the site and not overlap with each other as required.

Given that the servicing activity will be programmed to occur outside of peak hours, the activities will have no impact on the car parking activities.

Other smaller service vehicles, including vans, couriers, food catering, lift checking/maintenance, and other service personnel, only involve vans, utes, etc. will also be to use the loading space and the available kerbside parking.



5.0 Transport Impacts

Application of the RMS traffic generation criteria for "Private Hospital" to the proposed additional beds and staff would indicate the following:

AM Peak

 $10.21 + 0.47 \times 19 + 0.06 \times 4 = 20 \text{ vtph}$

PM Peak

 $2.84 + 0.25 \times 19 + 0.40 \times 4 = 10 \text{ vtph}$

B = Beds; S = Staff

Based on the above, the proposed development could potentially generate up to 20 additional vehicle trips per hour during peak hours. This equates to 1 vehicle trip per 3 minutes.

It should be noted that the above volumes would also comprise a significant proportion of movements from taxis and ride-share vehicles, with some of them already within the surrounding road network.

Given the minor additional traffic volumes generated by the proposed development, this additional traffic could not be expected to compromise the safety or function of the surrounding road network.



6.0 Site Access and Car Parking Layout

6.1 Site Access

It is to retain:

- ❖ a 4m-wide ingress driveway along Christina Street.
- ❖ a 6m-wide egress driveway along Lorna Leigh Lane.

The ingress and egress maneuvering arrangements at these driveways will be satisfactory, as confirmed by the turning path assessment for ambulance and MRV, provided in Appendix C.

The existing regular gaps in the traffic flow along Lorna Leigh Lane and Christina Street will allow vehicles to ingress and egress the driveways without any undue difficulty and delay.

6.2 Car Parking Layout

The car park layout has been reviewed against the requirements of the Australian Standard AS2890. This assessment included a review of the following:

- bay and aisle width
- adjacent structures
- turnaround facilities
- circulation aisles and ramps
- ramp grades

- height clearances
- parking for persons with disabilities
- bicycle parking

A review indicates that the proposed car parking layout is expected to operate satisfactorily, with all parking spaces, aisle widths, ramp grades/transitions and height clearances to be provided in accordance with the requirements of AS2890.1 and 6.

The swept path assessment indicating satisfactory provision for B85 car turning and maneuvering is provided in Appendix C.

All vehicles will be able to enter and exit the site via Christina Street and Lorna Leigh Lane in a forward direction.



7.0 Conclusions

There is an increasing demand for medical centre facilities as a consequence of ongoing urban development and population aging in the Lane Cove area. The existing Longueville Private Hospital at 43-47 Kenneth Street, Longueville presents an ideal opportunity for the expansion of services to provide for these needs.

The transport and parking assessment provided in this report confirms that:

- there will be very accessible and frequent public transport services available for staff, patients, and visitors
- the proposed development will present negligible traffic impacts on the surrounding road network
- the proposed car parking provision will be suitable and appropriate given the location of the Hospital and the ample on-street car parking
- the existing vehicle access and internal circulation arrangements will be suitable and appropriate
- the proposed car parking layout has been designed in accordance with AS2890.1 and 6 requirements
- the proposed loading/servicing arrangement will be suitable and adequate for the proposed development





The bus services shown in this timetable are run by Busways North West.

Fares

In Sydney and surrounding regions, fares are based on:

- the distance you travel from tap on to tap off
- the mode of transport you choose
- whether you're eligible for a concession fare or free travel
- any Opal benefits such as discounts and capped fares that apply.

You can use an Opal card or a contactless payment to pay for your travel.

Opal cards

An Opal card is a smartcard you keep and reuse. Add value before you travel, and tap on and tap off to pay your fares throughout Sydney, the Blue Mountains, the Central Coast, the Hunter and the Illawarra.

Which Opal card is right for you?

Adult – Customers 16 years or older who are not entitled to any concessions and normally pay full fare.

Child/Youth – For customers aged 4-15 (inclusive), or customers 16 years or older who hold a NSW/ACT Senior Secondary Student Concession Card.

Gold Senior/Pensioner – For eligible NSW and interstate seniors, pensioners, war widows/ers and asylum seekers.

Concession – For eligible tertiary students, job seekers, apprentices and trainees.

How to get an Opal card

You can get an Adult or Child/Youth Opal card over the counter at Opal retailers that display the Opal sign ②. To find your nearest retailer visit **transportnsw.info/opal**.

If you are eligible to travel with concession fares, you can apply for a Gold Senior/Pensioner or Concession Opal card online. Visit **transportnsw.info/opal** for more information.

Contactless payments

If you have an American Express, Mastercard, Visa card or linked device, you can use it to pay for all public transport on the Opal network. Just make sure to tap on and tap off at Opal readers at the beginning and end of your trip.

Always separate your cards when you tap on and tap off so your preferred card is charged.

You will receive the same travel benefits of an Adult Opal card when you tap on and tap off consistently with the same credit card, debit card or linked device. This includes daily, weekly and weekend travel caps, and a \$2 transfer discount when you change between metro/train, ferry, bus and light rail services within 60 minutes. Adult Opal fare pricing applies.


