KEY MATTERS DISCUSSED

The Panel notes the applicant's presentation and matters discussed with the applicant and council during the briefing. In particular, the Panel notes:

- Court approval. After the consent was Issued housing became a prohibited use due to bushfire risk. As a result, the development relies on existing use rights for permissibility.
- Councils main concern relates to existing use right provisions and whether the proposed use is consistent with the consent. Council is requesting an occupation certificate from the applicant to confirm legal advice and to be satisfied that the proposal is captured under existing use rights.
- The Applicant provided legal advice to council that states they benefit from existing use right provisions; this advice is being reviewed by council

NEXT STEPS

- RFI to be issued within 7-10 days with a response within 7 days.
- Council to contact the Department secretariat to schedule a determination date once further information is received from the applicant. Determination estimated for late June.

Note:

Council is yet to undertake its full application assessment, and therefore future comment will not be limited to matters discussed at the preliminary briefing.
