KEY MATTERS DISCUSSED

The Panel notes the matters discussed with the applicant and council during the briefing. In particular, the Panel notes:

- 6 objections received during public consultation.
- Council concerns include connectivity of the development, bulk and scale, amenity, building height, street presentation (use of materials), right of footway, and noncompliance with the apartment design guide (building separation, cross ventilation, vehicle access and parking).
- Further research should be provided on how congestion will be managed.
- Water NSW seeking additional information (Integrated referral dewatering).

NEXT STEPS

- RFI to be issued in the next 7 days with response likely by the end of June.
- Council to meet with the applicant to discuss content of the RFI.
- Determination estimated for August 2025.

Note:

Council is yet to undertake its full application assessment, and therefore future comment will not be limited to matters discussed at the preliminary briefing.
