### **KEY MATTERS DISCUSSED**

The Panel notes the applicant's presentation and matters discussed with the applicant and council during the briefing. In particular, the Panel notes:

- Council has obtained advice regarding whether the proposal is for multi dwelling housing versus a transitional group home, given the applicant indicates a transitional group home, whereas a legal objector has indicated multi-dwelling housing. Council will provide excerpts from their advice to the applicant for comment. The BCA also has a definition for group home.
- The Plan of Management is not to be made publicly available

- A further Panel briefing is to be held on 17 September prior to tentative determination in October
