Public meeting held at Christie Conference Centre, 100 Walker Street North Sydney, on 27 November 2019, opened at 2.30pm and closed at 2.34pm.

MATTER DETERMINED

PPSSNH-7 – Ku-ring-gai – MOD0198/18 at 2 Pymble Avenue Pymble for modifications to an approved development (as described in Schedule 1)

PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and briefings and the matters observed at site inspections listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

Development application

The panel determined to approve the development application pursuant to section 4.55 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

- The modified proposal is substantially the same as the original proposal.
- The modified proposal is within the envelope already approved, with the exception of three lift towers, two of each are higher and one lower by a small amount. The Panel is satisfied that the higher lift towers do not have any adverse visual impact.
- The amended proposal includes alteration to the on-site detention and bio-retention systems, which results in a failure to achieve the 50% of the site being deep-soil landscaping; however, the shortfall is minor.
- The remaining modifications are internal and have no material impact.

CONDITIONS

The development application was approved subject to the conditions in the council assessment report.

CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNITY VIEWS

The exhibition of the modification application attracted no submissions. No objectors attended the public meeting.
