KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

- In addition to issues raised at the Panel's kick-off briefing the following issues were discussed:
 - o Only one vehicular crossing from Canterbury Road to be included to the satisfaction of TfNSW
 - o Explore drop-off and loading below street level with lobby access to medical suites
 - Street level frontage to address Canterbury Road and provide active uses consistent with DCP requirements.
 - Configuration of medical suites to be provided
 - Proposed use and hours of operation for top floor tenancy and top floor terrace to be provided.
 - Waste storage and pick up area needs to be designed to meet Council requirements noting Council's preference for a heavy rigid vehicle (4.5m head clearance) may not be necessary for the uses proposed if a private waste contractor is employed.
