KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

In addition to the issues raised at the Panel's briefing on 21 June 2022, the following issues still need consideration:

- Housing SEPP still needs to be addressed. Loss of affordable housing is an issue
- Existing approved student numbers and projected population TBC
- Building heights and RLs needed. Accuracy of RLs questioned.
- Impacts of bulk, scale, and setbacks of new development on local context still to be addressed.
- Landscape plan: Plant species, sizes and schedule to be provided
- Overshadowing not satisfactory. Accuracy of modelling questioned
- Floor space ratio still non-compliant
- Traffic and parking report including bus and bike parking needs resolution. Limited opportunity for street parking.
- Security provisions: more detail required during school and out of hours
- Rationale for street tree removal.
- Need for acoustic report to determine noise impacts on neighbouring residential dwellings.
- Location of solar panels is queried.
