KEY MATTERS DISCUSSED:

The Panel notes the applicant presentation and matters discussed with the applicant and council during the briefing. In particular, the Panel notes:

- On exhibition till 17 September.
- Traffic and Parking concerns from 2 submissions. The applicant engaged with the school to the north to discuss the issue around parking, explaining that the current

- council parking being used by the school was not technically allocated to it. The Applicant advised the submitter was amenable once the circumstance was understood.
- Panel requested information on any previous consent in relation to existing versus proposed increases to intensity of use.

NEXT STEPS

- Applicant to provide information on prior consent, specifically: changes to hours of operation, parking and the number of people expected to use the facilities.
- External assessing officer expected to be appointed this week and RFI to be issued ASAP.
