KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

The Panel noted the Briefing Report provided by Council. The following matters were discussed:

- The updated site details and the amendments made to the development application, including the expansion of the development site to include additional lots where work is proposed.
- Owners consent remains outstanding for the unreferenced land parcel (*Ministers Land*) due to uncertainty regarding ownership.
- If ownership of the *Ministers Land* cannot be quickly clarified, the Applicant proposes to delete works within the *Ministers Land* with retention and no change to the existing encroachments.
- Contamination and the status of PSI which was provided to Council and which required a detailed site
 investigation (DSI). The applicant advised that the additional information will be forwarded to Council
 following the Briefing. Council will provide a response as to whether the "DSI" provides sufficient
 certainty that the site is suitable, or can be adequately remediated, to be fit for purpose for the
 intended future use

• Applicant has provided additional information to address Urban Design issues, which is being considered by Council's Urban Designer.

Next Steps

- Council to quickly confirm ownership of the *Ministers Land* and owners consent requirements for any works or encroachments. Alternatively, Applicant to amend plans to delete works within Minister's Land.
- Council's comments on urban design and "DSI" are to be finalised and applicant to be informed if further information is required.
- A tentative eDetermination date has been scheduled for 4 March 2024 and the Council Assessment Report is to be uploaded to the Planning Portal 7 days prior.
