## **KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED**

A range of issues were discussed. There main issues related to residential amenity of the proposed development. Specific issues that need further interrogation and resolution include:

- Justification for deviation from the development standards
- Need for solar access schedule (dates/times of day and year/duration) of apartments
- Shortfall in quantum of landscaped area
- ADG compliance issues including:
  - o Seatbacks between buildings and adjoining properties
  - o Residential amenity of subfloor area of Building B
  - Solar access to primary living areas and public open space
  - o Apartment sizes
  - $\circ$  Proportion, scale, quality and usability of communal open space
