KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

- Design changes implemented by the Applicant in response to refusal of DA19/0786. Changes were identified as including:
 - o Removal of roof terrace
 - o Redesign of basement to increase extent of deep soil zone
 - Increased setbacks on N/W side
 - Increased rear setback
- Context of the proposal in a medical precinct. Regard to be had to the character statement, what is the urban character to be delivered.
- Amalgamation of sites need to demonstrate that the principles in *Karavallas* have been satisfied.
- Impact of the proposal on adjoining sites if residential was to be proposed.
- Consideration of Design Review Panel comments to be demonstrated.
- Details of management of light spill from the proposal required in context of extensive glazing proposed and the residential nature of the surrounding locality.
- Variations to DCP controls to be identified and justified.
- Careful consideration required in terms of interface between the proposal and the surrounding locality.
- Detailed landscaping plan is required identifying extent of deep soli zones and planting schedule.

Planning Panels Secretariat

- In order to address concerns re character a coordinated approach is required to the selection of external material and the landscape treatment.
- Consideration be given to the incorporation of a green wall treatment.
- Scheme requires greater articulation in the built form and reduce reliance on use of louvres.
