## **KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED**

- There was Planning proposal on this site that has now been withdrawn.
- This site is a deferred matter so 1994 LEP applies. LEP 2012 and DCP apply to the immediate context.
- The main issues are:
  - the height and FSR controls in the DCP that are exceeded. Relationship to context needs to be considered.
  - Wayfinding and CEPTED needs resolution, specifically wayfinding from the public domain, from the carpark and from the shopping centre to the new facility.
  - Traffic, loss of parking and impacts on area needs resolution
  - o Materials and finishes and relationship to existing building to be considered
