### ISSUES LIST

- Public exhibition has concluded, and 1 submission was received.
- Council is yet to undertake its full application assessment, so this record is not a final list of the issues they will need to consider in order to draft their recommendation.
- The application is yet to be considered by the Sydney South Planning Panel and therefore future comment will not be limited to the detail contained within.

## **KEY ISSUES IDENTIFIED FOR CONSIDERATION**

The application seeks to modify the location of the buildings, stormwater disposal amendments, the field changing from a cricket pitch to a soccer field, deletion of the playground, grandstand reconfiguration, modification of the internal layouts of the grandstand and youth centre.

### **Panel comments:**

The proposal under consideration is a modification to a current approval (Master Plan approved 2016 and DA Consent Stage 2 & 3 and an initial modification in 2020). This modification is a response to discovery of a Sydney Water concrete culvert that impacts the development.

The key changes are as follows:

- The building is separated to provide a curtilage to the Sydney Water culvert.
- The main building is setback to modulate the façade
- Landscape has been introduced in the street setbacks
- Configuration of field has been changed from a cricket to soccer configuration to serve as a multi-purpose field and improve usability
- External tiered seating has been removed and replaced with landscaping and seating has been accommodated in building
- New pedestrian access paths from Cambridge Street
- Some changes to material and finishes

There does not appear to be any substantive impacts of the changes proposed and improvements incorporated include modulation of the street elevation, new landscaping and pedestrian routes.

The Panel notes that these works have already been completed and that this is a retrospective approval being sought.
