KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

- Existing situation
 - Site context
 - Existing unauthorised retaining wall along Hyams Beach interface with site
 - Existing approved earthworks
 - o Dual Occupancy development approved for the site
 - Extent of existing sea walls along the eastern boundaries of beach/private land interface
- Proposed Works
 - Construction of a 2.5metre-high sea wall along the extent of the rear boundary to provide coastal protection
 - o Proposed to tie in with concrete and rebar to existing approved retaining wall
- Statutory assessment framework, Shoalhaven DCP2014 and the Resilience and Hazards SEPP (2022), NSW Coastal Management Act 2016
- Timing of preparation of Coastal Management Plan for Hyams Beach.
- Cliff and recession lines
- Internal and external referrals
- The Panel requested the coastal hazard and geotechnical assessment be amended to include consideration of the following:
 - A holistic approach to coastal management across the coastal/private land interface along Hyams Beach

- o An assessment of the current beach impacts, having regard to the current retaining wall
- Details and confirmation of bedrock location and levels
- o Consideration of the coastal impacts of the works on adjoining properties
- o The impact of the creek to the south of the site on the sand levels on the beach
- The impact that the creek outlet may have on the wave assessment
- Impact on coastal processes on the beach and its access
- Likelihood and frequency of impacts
- Details of the offshore reef
- Consideration of Shoalhaven Water assets to ensure infrastructure is not undermined through future erosion
- Location of the toe of the sea wall
- The Panel requested Council seek further information from the applicant based on the above.
- The Panel requested the following documents be made available on the Planning Portal:
 - o All reports referenced in the SEE
 - o Any relevant geotechnical reports on adjoining land
 - o Relevant Chapters of the Shoalhaven DCP relating to coastal management

NEXT STEPS

- A site inspection scheduled for 29 June 2022 was cancelled due to weather
- A tentative site inspection date is being arranged for 26 July 2022
- Provision of details relating to design and approval of existing seawalls seaward of the proposed seawall and also on adjacent properties (80, 84 and 86 Cyrus Street)
