MATTER DETERMINED

PPSSTH-167 – Shellharbour – DA0291/2022 at Lot 2 DP 1144885 – Learning Centre, removal of 10 trees (as described in Schedule 1).

Development application

The Panel determined to approve the development application pursuant to section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The Panel determined to approve the application for the reasons outlined in the Council Assessment Report. The project is one that will have clear benefits to both the school and the wider community.

CONDITIONS

The Development Application was approved subject to the conditions in the Council Assessment Report with the minor amendments to the Councils recommended conditions as follows:

- Delete condition 6 Owners consent Reason: Condition is considered to be superfluous.
- Renumber conditions to reflect deletion of condition 6
- Reference NSW RFS GTAs in landscape plan condition (new condition 8)
 Reason: To ensure revised landscape plan is consistent with the NSW RFS GTAs
- Amend new condition 32b to reflect current name of Department of Planning and Environment

CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNITY VIEWS

In coming to its decision, the Panel noted there no written submissions were made during public exhibition and therefore no issues of concern were raised.
